Level 3 Diploma in Medical Science and Level 3 Certificate in Medical Science

I am pleased to confirm that we recognise the above qualifications as meeting entry requirements for our undergraduate degree programmes in the School of Medical Sciences, Bangor University.

At the time of writing, these are:

BMedSci (Hons) Medical Sciences
