Summer 2026

Next year's examination timetable has now been finalised. The dates for the GCE History examinations are as follows:

Unit 1	Wednesday, 13 May (afternoon)
Unit 2	Monday, 18 May (afternoon)
Unit 3	Tuesday, 2 June (afternoon)
Unit 4	Thursday, 11 June (morning)

In Summer 2025 centres uploaded NEA work for GCE History via IAMIS. This was a great success, and we thank you for your efforts in ensuring the moderation was a smooth process. In Summer 2026 we will use the same system. The deadline for submission of marked candidate work is **Friday, 15 May**.

Please remember that Summer 2026 is the first submission for the new three-year NEA cycle. Nearly all centres have now submitted their titles for this cycle. If you have not yet done so, please ensure that you submit your forms as soon as possible, and before your learners commence any work on their NEAs.
