

## Qualification and Sample Assessment Material writers and reviewers for new WJEC Level 3 Choc Vocational Qualifications

Our new Level 3 vocational qualifications are being primarily designed:

- for use with learners aged 16-18 as part of a post-16/sixth form programme of study
- to support progression to higher education
- to enable learners to gain Level 3 knowledge and understanding of a vocational area with opportunities to acquire associated practical and technical skills
- to complement other qualifications including GCEs, the new Advanced Skills Baccalaureate Wales (AdvSBW) and other Level 3 vocational qualifications.

Qualification writers and reviewers are central to the development of our qualifications. In this role you will be asked to undertake some or all of the following:

- produce specification content along with a rationale for inclusion that meet qualification requirements
- produce assessment content (tasks and mark schemes) that meet qualification and assessment specification requirements
- review specification/assessment content (question papers/tasks and mark schemes) to ensure that they meet qualification and assessment specification requirements
- submit assessment content in the required format, within agreed timescales
- ensure assessment content meets all commissioning instructions, as agreed with the qualification development officer
- provide additional assessment content as required, including document/image sources and details of copyright permission.
- attend paper review panel days and training sessions, as required (which will be held via Microsoft Teams, online).

## Experience / qualifications needed

- teaching and/or professional experience relevant to the sector
- knowledge and understanding of vocational qualifications
- good written communication skills particularly in your sector/subject areas of choice
- confident use of ICT
- ability to pick up new skills quickly and apply them

- ability to work to a tight deadline
- be able to write clearly and concisely.
