THE 2019/20 PL PROGRAMME

The <u>programme for 2019-2020</u> will largely migrate from supporting the introduction of reformed qualifications to providing feedback on the examination/assessment series and will consider implications for teaching, learning and future assessments. The events will focus on reviewing feedback from recent assessment series', consider candidate exemplar and also focus on pedagogy, practical classroom strategies and resources to improve performance.

We're also offering a range of thematic events this year. These events will focus on effective and innovative teaching and learning practices in and across subject areas and/or key stages.



THE CHANGING CURRICULUM FOR WALES

Curriculum reforms in Wales will have a significant impact on learners, practitioners and centres across Wales in the coming years. During 2019-20, we will develop close working partnerships with Wales' Regional Consortia and Welsh Government colleagues to explore how we can jointly develop models of Professional Learning, in line with Welsh Government's Education reform strategy; this will include changing the CPD title we currently use to "Professional Learning" from September 2019.

Our programme of events will be delivered in the following ways:

- face to face (full or half-day events typically in hotels or conference centres)
- live, online webinars (typically scheduled between 4-6pm)
- pre-recorded, online webinars (available free of charge on our website)

All of our courses are led by subject specialists who have in-depth experience and knowledge of the content. They will be classroom practitioners, our subject officers, specification developers, examiners or moderators with a wealth of experience within their field.

When you attend one of our courses, you will also be provided with a comprehensive pack of course materials, which you can take away with you and share with colleagues.

Preparing to Teach and Next Steps

Preparing to Teach courses are scheduled in the run-up to first teaching. Next Steps courses are offered during Year 1 of teaching.

These full-day sessions will look in-depth at a new specification, including its assessment objectives, examination structure and other key areas, and review sample assessment materials.

Outcomes:

- Review and develop understanding of the content and assessment requirements of the new specification.
- Understand the benefits of the qualifications for you and your learners.
- Support planning for teaching, including information on resources and useful contacts.
- Networking with colleagues and specialists

These events, held in partnership with City&Guilds, will primarily support the introduction of the <u>new suite of Health and Social Care and Childcare qualifications for Wales.</u> There will also be several networking events being held across the country to support the Practice elements of these qualifications.
