Applied ICT	<ul> <li>In Unit 3, the initial scenario will be treated as a 'teacher led' whole class activity instead of being completed by a number of small groups</li> </ul>	
Art and Design	Unit 3 (externally set assignment) will not be assessed	
Biology / Chemistry / Physics	<ul> <li>AS content that is not developed or required for Units 3 and 4 will not be assessed in summer 2022</li> <li>Biology - Identified content for Unit 4 will not be assessed</li> <li>Chemistry - Identified content for Unit 3 and Unit 4 will not be assessed</li> <li>Physics - Identified content for Unit 4 will not be assessed</li> </ul>	
Business	<ul> <li>Identified content for Unit 3 and Unit 4 will not be assessed</li> </ul>	
Computer Science	<ul> <li>Identified content for Unit 3 and Unit 4 will not be assessed</li> <li>In Unit 5 we will remove the requirement for learners to complete a prototype, post-prototype refinement of design and developmental testing</li> </ul>

English Literature	<ul> <li>Advance notice of extracts/poems to be assessed in the Unit 3 and Unit 4 examinations</li> </ul>	
French / German / Spanish	<ul> <li>In Unit 3 Speaking (NEA), the timing for one of the tasks will be reduced</li> <li>One identified subtheme will not be assessed in the Unit 4 examination</li> </ul>	
Geography	Section B (contemporary themes in geography) of the Unit 4 examination will cover one optional theme only	
Government and Politics	<ul> <li>Identified content for Unit 3 and Unit 4 will not be assessed</li> </ul>

Health and Social Care, and Childcare	<ul> <li>In Unit 4 NEA (childcare pathway) Task 1, part (b)(ii) and (e)(i) will not be assessed</li> <li>In Unit 6 NEA (health and social care pathway) Task 1, part (b)(ii) and (e)(i) will not be assessed</li> </ul>
History	<ul> <li>In the Unit 3 examination, narrow-timeframe questions will not be assessed</li> </ul>
ICT	<ul> <li>Identified content for Unit 3 will not be assessed</li> <li>In Unit 4 we will remove the requirement for learners to complete the evaluation stage</li> </ul>
Law	<ul> <li>Identified content for Unit 3 and Unit 4 will not be assessed</li> </ul>
Mathematics and Further Mathematics	<ul> <li>Identified content for Mathematics Unit 3 and Unit 4 will not be assessed</li> <li>Identified content for Further Mathematics Unit 4, Unit 5 and Unit 6 will not be assessed</li> </ul>
Media Studies	<ul> <li>In Unit 3 the number of set products studied for each section will be reduced from three to two</li> <li>Learners will create one media product only in the Unit 4 NEA and requirements (time/pages/images) will be reduced</li> <li>Partially completed productions for Unit 4 NEA will be accepted</li> </ul>
Music	<ul> <li>Performing time will be reduced in Unit 4</li> <li>Only one composition will be required in Unit 5 (option A)</li> <li>Only two compositions will be required in Unit 5 (option B)</li> <li>One of the two subsidiary set works in Unit 6 Area of Study F Strands 1 and 2 will be removed</li> </ul>
Physical Education	<ul> <li>In Unit 4 NEA the Investigative Research Project will be assessed on the first two sections only:</li> <li>Complete an initial analysis of personal performance identifying appropriate research to help improve performance</li> <li>Evaluate the research, including data, to make recommendations and a plan for improving performance</li> </ul>
Psychology	• In Section A of the Unit 3 examination, learners will be required to answer two questions rather than three questions.
Religious Studies	<ul> <li>Identified content (Theme 1) will not be assessed in the Unit 4 examination</li> <li>Identified content (Theme 4) will not be assessed in the Unit 5 examination</li> </ul>
Sociology	Advance notice of some aspects to be assessed in the Unit 3     examination
Welsh Language	<ul> <li>In Unit 5 the number of poems to be studied will be reduced from seven to six</li> <li>In Unit 6 the number of writing forms to be studied will be reduced from seven to five</li> </ul>
