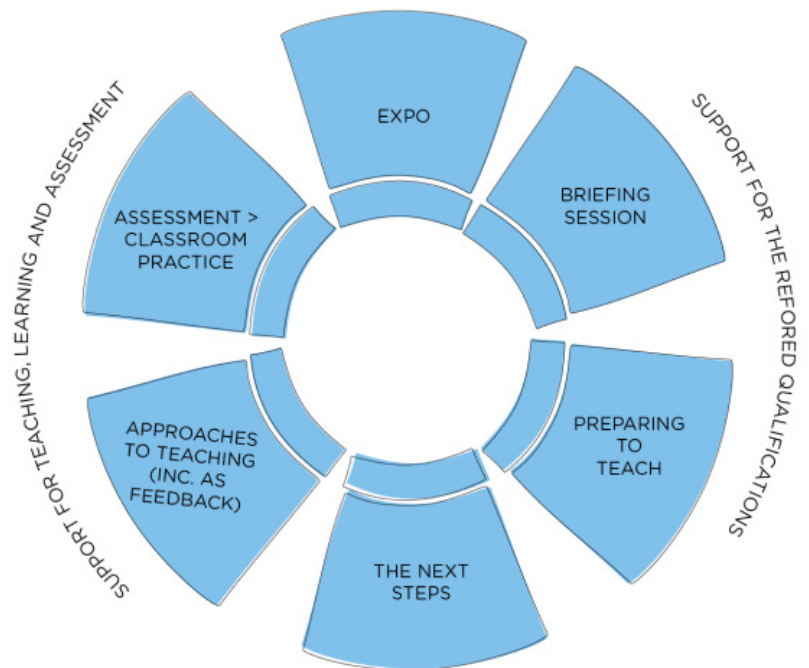

THE 2019/20 CPD PROGRAMME

The [programme for 2019-2020](#) will largely migrate from supporting the introduction of reformed qualifications to providing feedback on the examination/assessment series and will consider implications for teaching, learning and future assessments. The events will focus on reviewing feedback from recent assessment series', consider candidate exemplar and also focus on pedagogy, practical classroom strategies and resources to improve performance.

We're also offering a range of thematic events this year. These events will focus on effective and innovative teaching and learning practices in and across subject areas and/or key stages

Our programme of events will be delivered in the following ways:

- face to face (full or half-day events typically in hotels or conference centres)
- live, online webinars (typically scheduled between 4-6pm)
- face to face centre-based (preferably with groups of centres)
- pre-recorded, online webinars (available free of charge on our website)

All of our courses are led by subject specialists who have in-depth experience and knowledge of the content. They will be classroom practitioners, our subject officers, specification developers, examiners or moderators with a wealth of experience within their field.
