Entry Codes

To make entries for WJEC AS/A level Law you need to enter multiple unit codes and the cash-in code if applicable (AS cash in for year one is optional, A level cash in for year 2 is required). This lets us know the units the candidates will be sitting within the academic year and whether or not the candidate will receive certification. Overall Grade Boundaries are available on page 23 of the [specification](#).

Grade boundaries are expressed on a Uniform Mark Scale (UMS). UMS grade boundaries remain the same every year as the range of UMS mark percentages allocated to a particular grade does not change. UMS grade boundaries are published at overall subject and unit level.

Results Information

A range of information is available to centres after each examination series via the secure site – [Portal by WJEC - Select a Centre](#) – under the 'RESULTS' tab.

This information includes **Summary of Subject Results** – providing a final mark and grade for all candidates who sat a particular paper or qualification. **Component Marks** – listing the overall mark, grade and breakdown at unit level for each candidate at each qualification. It also shows you where the grade boundaries sit and the aggregate of each paper. This option shows you where in the grade the candidate has fallen for a particular paper. **Centre Performance** – this provides a table which compares the results of this centre to every other.
