PURPOSE

The purpose of the Community Challenge is to develop learners' skills, whilst encouraging learners to identify, develop and participate in opportunities that will benefit a community. During the Community Challenge learners will explicitly develop skills of **Planning and Organisation** and **Personal Effectiveness** and apply them in an appropriate manner.

BRIEF

In this Challenge you will be given the opportunity to make a positive contribution to the local, regional, national or international community. You will focus on real-life concerns and needs whilst engaging in activities which aim to make a real difference. The Community Challenge should provide experiences that help you understand what it means to be an active citizen. The challenge should enable you to develop as effective and responsible members of the community. In completing the Community Challenge you will be able to recognise the contributions you can make towards improving the chosen community and the benefits this will have for you, for others and for the environment. Where appropriate, you will be able to demonstrate independence, responsibility and an ability to work well with others.



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As a member of a community you have a social responsibility to consider others within your community. Consideration for others includes helping, supporting and developing opportunities, helping to ensure that they better fulfil their personal goals and reach their potential in a supportive and optimal environment.

Pembrokeshire Coast National Park is a special landscape that must be conserved and enhanced for the benefit of its natural beauty, wildlife and cultural heritage. The Park Authority must also promote the opportunities for people to enjoy and understand its special qualities. The Pembrokeshire Coast National Park is the perfect playground for you to get out, get active and get healthy. The combination of sea, land and air offers an exciting mix of outdoor activities for everyone to enjoy, from adrenaline sports to a simple stroll. The EnjoyPembrokeshire website provides details of a wide range of activities and their health benefits. The Park has locations and facilities ideally suited for outdoor activities.

The Pembrokeshire Coast National Park Authority would like your help to encourage more local young people to use their natural outdoor environment to support a healthy lifestyle and better understanding of the natural world. As an individual or small team, PCNPA would like you to create opportunities/events for a community group of your choice to participate in outdoor events and activities within the National Park. Particular attention will need to be taken to ensure an activity or event is carried out in a sustainable manner to minimise the environmental impact on the area you choose. The outcome of the activity/event will hopefully encourage the participants to continue accessing the benefits of the National Park

This opportunity should be developed and implemented over a minimum period of 4 weeks and include at least 30 hours of active engagement and participation. Consideration must be given to how you would be best placed to develop and support these opportunities along with key factors such as health and safety, needs of and benefits to the community.
