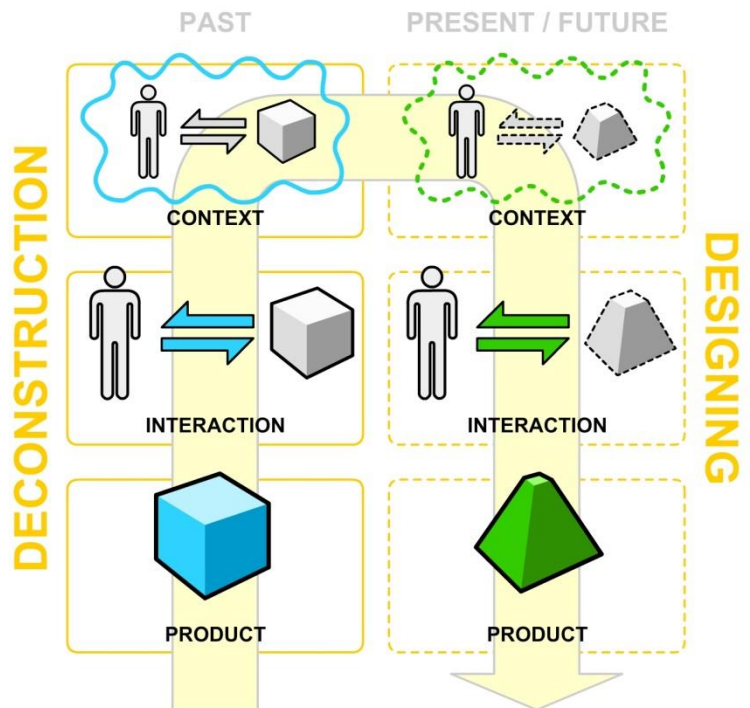
PURPOSE

The purpose of the Enterprise and Employability Challenge is to develop learners' skills, whilst providing opportunities for learners to develop enterprising skills and attributes and enhance employability. During the Enterprise and Employability Challenge learners will explicitly develop skills in **Numeracy, Digital Literacy, Creativity and Innovation** and **Personal Effectiveness** and apply them in an appropriate manner.

BRIEF

The Enterprise and Employability Challenge provides you with an opportunity to develop important team working skills by creating and implement innovative ideas based on meeting the needs of customers by developing a product linked to your Learning Programme. This can be achieved and enhanced by following an enterprise process which includes interacting with successful local entrepreneurs.

As a team of 3 to 6 members, using skills, knowledge and understanding developed through your Engineering Programme; design a product that promotes the best of Wales to the world. Your team must develop a business proposal for your new product.



The final proposals must be illustrated in a visual display which should be as creative and imaginative as possible. The team will then pitch the proposal to a panel.

The Enterprise and Employability Challenge provides you with an opportunity for you to show how creative and innovative you can be including the use of digital technology, as well as demonstrating people skills such as developing a rapport, listening skills, negotiating skills and trusting others. You may also demonstrate your assertiveness and leadership qualities.
